## ABOUT THE COURSES

Choose between two classroom-style NICET exam preparation courses. Each course is two days in duration and covers Level I, II and III topics, including design, installation, inspection, testing and maintenance. The course is designed for anyone considering or preparing to take a certification exam or simply seeking additional knowledge of the codes and standards and general work practices. Exam study materials should be purchased in advance and brought to the course and are not included with registration. Specific information on required materials for each course is below. Experienced instructors will guide participants through a detailed review of applicable codes and will provide participants with a thorough understanding of NICET and the certification process. Courses will include but are not limited to a review and explanation of applicable codes, definitions, example test questions, and test taking tips.
