



Seminar 1: Fire Alarm NICET Class

This seminar will present the codes and standards that can be expected during the NICET Level I and Level II Fire Alarm System (FAS), and the Inspection and Testing of Fire Alarm Systems (ITFAS) exams. Attendees will learn test-taking techniques and time management strategies that will enhance their performance during an exam in a timed environment. The seminar will cover fire alarm system fundamentals; the requirements for documentation; fire alarm initiating devices and notification appliances; the inspection, test and maintenance; emergency control functions; and Protected Premises Fire Alarm Systems.
